Applicants should have prior familiarity with international human rights law, gained through prior employment experience and/or coursework. Applicants should be available to work 10-15 hours per week, starting as soon as possible and through November 2016. The majority of anticipated assignments can be carried out remotely, although availability to work at least one day per week from the JBI office (located at 56th Street and 3rd Avenue in New York City) is preferred. Fluency in English is required.
