E. Robert Goodkind, a partner in the New York law firm of Pryor Cashman LLP, chaired AJC's Jacob Blaustein Institute for the Advancement of Human Rights (JBI) Administrative Council from 2007 until 2014. Before that he was president of AJC from 2004 through 2007, and now serves on the board of AJC's Dorothy and Julius Koppelman Institute on American Jewish-Israeli Relations, and the Steering Committee of the Contemporary Jewish Life Commission. He has been AJC treasurer and chairman of its National Council and Board of Trustees and its Contemporary Jewish Life and Domestic Affairs Commissions. A past president of AJC Westchester/Fairfield, Mr. Goodkind received AJC's Distinguished Leadership Award in 1991 and 2007. He is on the Board of Directors of the Israel Policy Forum. He has been chairman of the Jewish Museum, the Jewish Foundation for the Righteous, and the American Academy of Dramatic Arts. He is currently a board member of the Jewish Broadcasting System. In 2008 he was awarded the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters from Hebrew College, and in 2012 received the Richard C. Holbrooke Award for Social Justice by Blue Card. Mr. Goodkind graduated from Princeton University and Harvard Law School.
